The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program was developed by FEMA and teaches people to safely help in a disaster before professionals arrive

Topics include:

- Disaster awareness
- Damage assessment
- Search & Rescue
- Emergency communications
- Basic medical skills
- Transporting, triaging, & treating survivors— Saving Lives!
- Fire suppression
- Disaster psychology
- Hazardous materials
- Incident Command Structure and CERT organization
- Terrorism awareness
