What is the ShakeOut?

- Each year, Be Ready Utah leads an effort to pause and to practice responding to an earthquake
- This provides opportunities for all of us to work together to be more ready for such a disaster

WHY is this Important?

- A massive earthquake shakes the Wasatch fault every 350 to 400 years
- It has been about 350 years since the last major quake in this area
